Award 1:

Nutrien's Lima Facility identifies, analyses, and mitigates behaviors & conditions that could lead to a significant injury/fatality. They eliminate issues through cross functional teams that identify precursors and work to mitigate the hazards. They also use contact rates to ensure that personnel get regular visits at their job site to discuss the potential for SHE events and how to mitigate the issues. They must achieve a contact rate of at least 2.7 contacts per person to remain injury free month.

Award 2:

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, Nutrien's Lima Facility started producing it's own emergency response training videos. In conjunction with local fire departments from several communities and vendors, the ER Coordinator and a sr. ERT member created training materials that met the 2020 training schedule. At a minimum, one video is sent out weekly with demonstrations, supporting documentation and photos. All videos are

kept on SharePoint and the Nutrien Microsoft streaming website.

Award 3:

Nutrien's Lima Facility holds weekly meetings with each contract company. Meeting topics include information from the Contractor Safety Report. They discuss any SHES findings that could present potential for serious injury or fatality in the previous weeks work or for the work they are preparing for during the current week and methods to mitigate them. The facility also covers positive employee recognition for any worker that has been found to be going above and beyond their routine duties.

The Ohio Chemistry Technology Council recently announced the recipients of their Annual Awards for Excellence which recognizes Ohio chemical companies who have demonstrated exceptional performance in environmental, health, safety and security over the previous year. Awards were presented to 17 facilities from around Ohio, all of which had significant contributions and achievements in 2020.
