In addition to the standard protocols, Nutrien Lima outfitted all employees and contractors on site with close contact tracking units in order to control the spread of the Covid 19 virus within the facility. These units, when within about 6 feet of each other, produce a warning signal to the wearers that they are not providing the adequate social distancing required to prevent the spread of the Covid virus. Furthermore, the units record any close contacts and several gateways are located within the facility to receive and record the reports from the individual units. If an individual contracts the virus, his/her units info is analyzed and all close contacts are notified so that they may then take the appropriate actions to further minimize the spread.

The Ohio Chemistry Technology Council recently announced the recipients of their Annual Awards for Excellence which recognizes Ohio chemical companies who have demonstrated exceptional performance in environmental, health, safety and security over the previous year. Awards were presented to 24 facilities from around Ohio, all of which had significant contributions and achievements in 2021.
